<p>EXTRAS</p>	<p><u>Library:</u> Students can borrow books, provided that they return them in due time before their departure.</p> <p><u>Catering:</u> ASFA holds a restaurant in its premises in Peiraios street, where Erasmus students can have breakfast, lunch and dinner at a reduced price (currently 2,50€ per day for any or all three meals).</p> <p><u>Academic ID card:</u> offers reduction in public transport and entrances to museums.
